Transportation Best Management Practices

Oklahoma State University and Oklahoma 4-H do not own or control private vehicles. Transportation relies on drivers complying with state laws, Oklahoma State University policies, and 4-H guidelines.

Insurance & Liability:

- Oklahoma is self-insured under the Governmental Tort Claims Act (Title 51 §151 et seq.).
- Coverage applies to certified volunteers performing official 4-H duties (not personal 4-H business).
- All vehicles must carry liability insurance and be operated by licensed drivers.

Passenger Vans:

- 12-15 passenger vans require drivers to be 21+ and certified in Precision Driving.
- Vans must not be filled to capacity.
- See OSU Policy 1-0133 and Student Travel Policy for details.

Transportation to/from 4-H Events:

- 1. Parents/guardians are responsible for their child's transportation.
- 2. Alternate arrangements must be made by parents/guardians:
 - Done at their discretion.
 - · All parties should understand liability.
 - · A signed parental release is recommended.
- 3. Extension educators or certified volunteers may transport youth.
- 4. Vehicles must be in good repair with one seatbelt per person.
- 5. Transporting youth in pickup beds is prohibited.
- 6. Drivers must carry a copy of each child's medical release form during transport.

Teen Drivers:

- Parents may choose to have their teen travel to events in a carpool or drive themselves. When doing so, parents assume full responsibility for their child's transportation arrangements.
- Youth driving to events must park and not use the vehicle during the event.
- Violations may result in loss of 4-H participation privileges.
- Be aware of Oklahoma's Graduated Driver Licensing (GDL) guidelines for drivers under age 18.

Liability Considerations (in case of accident):

- Was the activity consistent with the 4-H mission?
- Was it part of the regular program?
- Was the trip authorized and permitted by policy?
- Were drivers licensed, trained, and compliant with laws?
- Was the vehicle safe and equipped with seatbelts?
- Were passengers behaving appropriately?
