MATERIALS NEEDED

Cardboard Box

Scissors

Tape

Bobby Pins or Paper Clips



STEPS

Step 1: Draw a circle about the size of your palm on the cardboard box.

Step 2: Cut out the circle. Decorate the box if you wish.

Step 3: Take bobby pins or paper clips and bend them open. Tape them to the box so that the end is reaching over the opening of your circle.

SAFETY FIRST

MATERIALS NEEDED

Sunscreen

Insect Repellent



Sunscreen

Always apply your sunscreen before your repellents

Apply the sunscreen to both arms, legs, and anywhere that may be exposed to the sun's hot rays

Do not apply in circular motions, as this could waste product. Instead, apply in long strokes or lines across the surface of your skin.

Avoid contact with eyes and mouth

Insect Repellent

Never spray against the wind, you will lose product and risk missing critical areas

Use the wind to your advantage, spray with the current to help move along product

Spray 3-5 inches from skin surfaces

Make sure to cover both front and back of all areas, don't forget the ankles and elbows!
