### **GENERAL RULES:**

-Athletes must be Oklahoma 4-H members in "active" status on ZSuite.

-Athletes must be 4-H certified in their respective discipline in order to participate.

-Ages will be based on August 1, 2024.

-Entry Fee will be \$7.00 per event.

-There will be awards for this contest presented at the conclusion of all competitions.

-Pre-registration is due by Monday, October 21, 2024. Use the provided entry form.

-Athletes may participate in two divisions (compound, recurve, genesis).

-All non-athletes are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful, non-disruptive manner.

\*\*Must be 9 years of age and been enrolled for 30 days. All other ages will be determined using members age as of August 1, 2024.

Athletes will be allowed 5 practice arrows at first distance!

Safety Notice: When drawing back the string of the bow an athlete must not use any technique which, in the opinion of the judges, could allow the arrow, if accidentally released, to fly beyond the safety zone (net, wall etc.). The athlete MUST be able to draw on target each and every time. NO SKY DRAWING! If an athlete persists in using such a technique, he or she will, in the interest of safety, be asked by the Safety Director to stop shooting and to leave the field.

Coaches, participants, and parents/guardians are responsible for reading the rules, knowing the rules of their events, and complying with the rules and established equipment guidelines.

#### **Equipment Standard:**

#### Recurve

- One adjustable sight pin, multiple target sight pins, clicker, kisser button and torque compensators (stabilizers) are permitted.
- > String peeps and mechanical release aids are not permitted.
- ➢ 60 lb. maximum draw weight. (+/- 21bs.)

#### Genesis

Genesis Bow (or equivalent with no let off) with less than 2511 pull may be shot. Finger tabs and Archery finger gloves are permitted.

#### **Compound** (freestyle)

- Any bow that uses pullies or cams is deemed a compound.
- > Release aids, string peeps, optical sights and spirit levels are permitted.
- > Overdraws may not place the arrow rest further than 6 cm from the pivot point of the bow.
- ▶ 60 lb. maximum draw weight. (+/- 2 lbs.)

#### Arrows -

- > Arrows must meet AMO minimum weight standard.
- ▶ 6 grains arrow weight per pound bow peak draw weight.
