

1. Where is the record function? As the “Presenter” it will be visible on the Black Tool bar.
2. Can a participant record meeting? No, that feature is only for the host.
3. How can they see your recording? When the meeting ends, you will be given an option to upload to the Cloud or to the computer.
4. On the computer, the red recording button is in the top left corner
5. Kathrine the host or cohost will be able to see the record button and they will be the only ones that will have access to that.
6. You might not be able to see the record since you are not the host. If you “host” a meeting, it pops up. Once it is completed, you will receive a link.
